



Aquatic Invasive Species Report

SHORELINE MONITORING

For the last three years, the Lake Belle Taine Association has sponsored an organized monitoring project to find any



invasive species before it spreads to the whole Lake. This project involves trained volunteers searching a designated two-mile area of shoreline for invasive species. We are happy to report that no invasive species were found.
